Chairperson Report

Since the March 2023 Newsletter there has been lots of activity behind the scenes aimed at updating the membership experience of walking with the group.

A new walk programme has successfully been introduced with some shorter, easier walks included.

The web page contact us and recent news column have been up dated and used effectively to keep members informed. Late changes to walk information have been published there, in addition to emails being sent to members whenever possible.

A new revitalised Facebook page has been created. There is a link included on the Web page, under the contact us tab, which is an easy way to access it.

Anyone taking pictures on the walks is reminded to check with those present that they are happy to be included. This is a requirement of the group. Posting onto Facebook will be checked by our administrator. Most of the pictures are of the beautiful surrounds, flora and fauna met along the way.

The group successfully bid for funding from West Lancashire Heritage Society which has been dissolved. The Heritage Group was known to a number of West Lancashire Footpath group members. Amongst other successes they were involved with bringing the "War Horse" story and walk to the attention of the wider North West public. The donation of £500 will enable our insurance, web hosting and Ramblers affiliation, fees to be paid into 2024.

Our Charity Commission records have been updated to include the changes to the trustee information. This information is available for "public" viewing.
